Good behaviour is a fundamental requirement for learning to take place in school. Our behaviour policy is designed to create a positive, safe and enjoyable learning environment. *The support of parents and carers is usually the biggest factor in improving behaviour.* What is really important to understand is that behaviour is *not* a judgement on a child or family, it is a judgement on the behaviour that is taking place.

Celebration assembly on Fridays.

Star of the day.

Stickers.

Postcards home.

Phone call home.

Speaking to parents at the end of the day.

Golden Time.

Termly role of honour for behaviour role models.

Home school agreement.

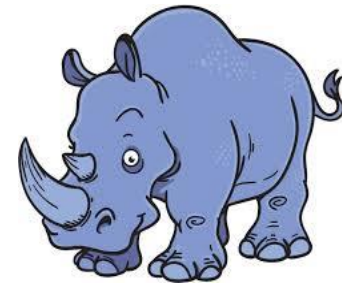
