

Levels of unacceptable behaviour and consequences KS1 & KS2

Level 1 (Naughtiness)

Name calling
Wasting resources
Antisocial crude behaviour
Wandering around classroom
Irritating noises
Calling out/shouting
Chewing gum/eating sweets
Lateness into classroom
Lolling over desks
Talking while teacher is talking
Fidgeting/rummaging
Teasing/winding up others
Dropping litter
Unsociable behaviour at lunchtime
Homework not done
Forgetting books/reply slips
Wearing inappropriate clothing

Consequences:

Warning from adult
Class traffic light system applied
Sitting/working alone
Isolation in a safe supervised place
Missing part of playtime
Missing part of lunchtime

Level 2 (Serious incidents)

Persistent level 1 incidents
Misuse classroom equipment
Swearing in conversation
Not working
Answering back/arguing with adult
Uncooperative behaviour
Throwing or flicking objects
Interfering with other people's property
Telling lies
Name calling
Writing graffiti
Walking away from an adult when being spoken to
Pushing another person out of the way
Misuse of toilets and wash areas
Making unkind remarks about another child's family
Making fun of another child's work
Leaving the class without permission

Consequences:

Missing all playtime
Missing all lunch play
Spend time in another class
Taken to Head or Deputy Head
Parent informed by class teacher

Level 3 (Very serious incidents)

Persistent level 2 incidents
Intentional spitting
Swearing at another person
Threatening behaviour
Refusing to follow safety instructions
Throwing objects at another person
Racist or minority group abuse
Refusing to go to Headteacher or designated person
Bullying
*[Bullying: Defined as **persistent and deliberate** undermining of a person's self-esteem and feelings of well-being in whatever form this takes]*

Consequences:

Sustained missing of play and lunchtime play
Parents invited to meet teacher/senior leader
Child excluded at lunchtime
Internal exclusion from class
Letter home to warn of external exclusion
Child put on behaviour report

Level 4 (Major incidents that may lead to exclusion from school)

Persistent level 3 incidents
Inappropriate touching
Theft
Physically violent behaviour
Using objects as weapons
Absconding from the site
Vandalism

Consequences:

Major incident report completed
Parent meeting with senior manager
Sustained internal exclusion
External exclusion
Negotiated transfer to another school
